

Saint Andrews Presbyterian Preschool Fieldtrip Driver Information

Thank you so much for volunteering to drive some of your child's classmates on fieldtrips. We ask that you read the following guidelines before you drive on a trip. If you have any questions, please feel free to check with your child's teacher or with the Director, Marj Jenkins.

- No child is to be seated in the front passenger seat.
- Each child must have his/her own seatbelt.
- According to NC law, children less than age 8 or 80 pounds must be properly secured in a correctly installed weight-appropriate safety seat. Every parent must install their child's car seat themselves. At age 8, a seat belt **may** be used instead of a safety seat.
- If a child is misbehaving while you are driving, please stop the car and explain to the child that he/she must behave appropriately before you can go any further.
- Saint Andrews Preschool does not carry Automobile Insurance that would give you coverage in case of an accident.
- You must fill out a "Fieldtrip Driver Form" before driving on any trip.
- Please be at school by the appointed time for fieldtrips so that the class can all leave on time.
- It is the policy of the preschool that siblings do not come on the fieldtrips.
